Dear Child Care Provider:

On May 24, 2021, the **New York State Interim Guidance for Child Care, Day Care, Day Camp and Overnight Camp Programs During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency** was further amended. Children 2 years of age and older are encouraged, but are no longer required to wear a face covering when in the child care facility or in outdoor spaces exclusively used by the child care program. Children are still required to wear face coverings when off-site (for example, when taken to public parks or on field trips). The updated guidance can be found [here](#).
